ELIT 544 20th CENTURY BRITISH POETRY (UP TO THE 1960s) (404)

In this course, the student is to recognise the changes observed in British poetry during the transition period from the 19^{th} century to the 20^{th} century, to comprehend the 20^{th} century poetic tradition in relation to British history, culture and literature of the period, to analyse and discuss the changes in the 20^{th} century poetic tradition through some representative works with a comparative approach.
